

MADAGASKAR TOUR SOUTH

Day 1	<p>ANTANANARIVO</p> <p>We meet you in international Airport Ivato. Transfer to the hotel Panorama***, breakfast included.</p>	Hotel Panorama
Day 2	<p>ANTANANRIVO – ANTSIRABE</p> <p>We leave in the early morning, after breakfast. On the road, we will stop in Ambatolampy, in order to visit the factory of aluminum. There we can also buy different things made of aluminum such as knives and other souvenirs. The views there are truly magnificent. Antsirabe: town known for its thermal waters. There we can observe the work of precious gems cutters. This town is also known for its miniatures such as souvenirs of zebu horn.</p>	Royal Palace Hôtel
Day 3	<p>ANTSIRABE – RANOMAFANA</p> <p>Before our departure we will have a little excursion around the town. On our way to Ranomafana we will stop in Ambositra – very important town of Madagascar, because of its market range. Ambositra also specializes in wood production. There we can find a huge variety of sculpture of wood such as Rose wood, Eben etc. Ranomafana National Park generally consists of tropical forests with average temperature of 15 to 22 °C. Animals that live there are divided by family groups, especially lemurs. Apart from flora and fauna, visitors can enjoy the thermal waters and local markets.</p>	Setam Lodge
Day 4	<p>RANOMAFANA – AMBALAVAO</p> <p>Befor departure, visit of the park with its fauna and flora: lemurs, medical plants, orchids. On our way, we will stop in Fianarantsoa town. This town is considered as economic, cultural and religious center. High regions of this town are the most interesting ones. There we can find a huge sculpture of Saint Virgin. According to history, this sculpture was built as the respect to the Queen Ranavalona the 1st. On the road we can observe vine plantations, mountains and legendary rocks. Ambalavao is famous for its various architecture. There we will visit cloth factory, factory of paper production and some vine plantations. There will be able to taste different sorts of vine from the local regions. Approximately 12 km. we can find the Anja Park, where we will be able to see Catta lemurs (Madagascar Maki) and many lizards.</p>	Les Bougainvilliers hotel
Day 5 – 6	<p>AMBALAVAO – RANOHIRA</p> <p>In the early morning, we will go to this wonderful park. There we can observe canyons, spears of minerals, massif rocks and many grottos. Then we will move to natural swimming pool and natural window of Isalo.</p>	Le Relais de la reine
Day 7	<p>RANOHIRA – TULEAR</p> <p>On our way there we will stop and observe the villages that are specialized in precious stones mining. There we will also find the incredible baobabs, including a Holy Baobab. We will also have a</p>	Chez Victory

	<p>chance to see a funerary of Mahafaly tribe – structures, characterized by “Aloalos”: geometrical wooden sculptures. Tulear is a big town of colonial style. Very hot climate is typical for this region. Singing and dancing in the evening is traditional for Tulear and its citizens.</p>	
Day 8 – 9	<p>TULEAR – ANAKAO</p> <p>We will continue our trip to South (27 km). Anakao is a small village of fishermen. This region has a formidable beach. There we can enjoy sea and sun to our heart’s content. In the waters of this region we organize snorkeling, fishing and other water activities. From July to September we organize whales’ observation trips in close range. There, we can also try out local traditional transport – pirogue. A couple of kilometers away from Anakao, we can find holy island called Nosy ve. Magic views, local flora and fauna make this trip unforgettable. Many scientists all over the world come to this island, in order to study local endemic birds such as “Pailles-en-queue”.</p>	Ocean Anakao Lodge
Day 10	<p>ANAKAO – TULEAR – FORT DAUPHIN</p> <p>In the morning, we will get back to Tulear. Then we will head to the airport and fly to Fort Dauphin.</p> <p>Fort-Dauphin or Taolagnaro is one of the most important touristic centers of Madagascar. The luxury level of local beaches (Libanona, Lokaro) is truly high. According to the history, Taolagnaro is the first town that was founded by Europeans in 16th century. It will be extremely interesting to visit a botanic garden with beautiful plantations of south region.</p>	Le Dauphin
Day 11 – 12	<p>FORT DAUPHIN – BERENTY</p> <p>We leave Fort Dauphin, in the morning. The road is not good but full of adventure and new impressions. The road itself is surrounded by botanic region of semi-desert, where we can find a funerary of Antanosy tribe with its memorial stones. A Check In follows after the arrival to Berenty. Then we will visit an Eco-touristic reserve of 340 hectares, founded in 1936. There we will be able to observe amazing flora and fauna such as lemurs Catta, sifaka, turtles, pachypodium snakes etc. Then, we should not forget to visit a local museum of artisans from Antandroy tribe.</p>	Berenty Lodge
Day 13	<p>BERENTY – FORT DAUPHIN – ANTANANARIVO</p> <p>We will move to the airport and get back to Antananarivo.</p>	Hotel Panorama
Day 14	<p>ANTANANARIVO</p> <p>There we will have an excursion around the city. We will also have a chance to visit the artisanal market for buying local souvenirs. Day use in the hotel, then transfer and check-in for the flight back.</p>
